## **An update on project activities planned from January to March 2016 for Woolgoolga to Halfway Creek**

**The NSW and Australian governments are jointly funding the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade, which includes the 14 kilometre Woolgoolga to Halfway Creek section.**

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted OHL and York to upgrade this 14 kilometre section. Work started in June 2015 and is expected to be open to traffic in 2017, weather permitting.

### **Work to date**

Some of the activities carried out include:

- Surveys, clearing, mulching and boundary fencing
- Monitoring dust, noise and water quality
- Utility adjustments
- Started controlled blasting
- Upgraded the Hawthorn Close and Kangaroo Trail Road intersections with the Pacific Highway
- Started building the Sherwood Creek Road, Kangaroo Trail Road, Cassons Creek and Corindi floodplain bridges
- Started earthwork and drainage
- Completed new access arrangements at Rediger Close and Grays Road, Halfway Creek
- Installed temporary concrete barriers and erosion and sediment controls.

### **Upcoming work**

Work planned in the next three months includes:

- Controlled blasting
- Surveys and boundary fencing
- Earthwork and drainage, and start placement of road gravel
- Bridge work at Sherwood Creek Road, Kangaroo Trail Road, Cassons Creek and Corindi floodplain bridges
- Start staged upgrade of Eggins Drive at Arrawarra
- Property adjustments
- Moving local traffic on to the Sherwood Creek Road overpass bridge
- Moving local traffic on to the Dundoo Reach access road
- Building the Corindi access road.

## Work hours

Most of the work will be carried out from 7am to 6pm weekdays, and Saturdays from 8am to 5pm, weather permitting.

In areas where residents live more than 200 metres from the project boundary, extended work hours from **6am to 7pm weekdays** are allowed.

Out of hours work may also be carried out with approval from the Department of Planning and Environment, after consultation with nearby residents, or in line with the project's Conditions of Approval. We will let you know ahead of time if this needs to happen.
