UPGRADING THE PACIFIC HIGHWAY: WOOLGOOLGA TO WELLS CROSSING ROUTE OPTIONS DISPLAY

Dear Sir/Madam

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is in the process of identifying a highway upgrade route from Woolgoolga to Wells Crossing.

As you may be aware, the RTA has engaged GHD Pty Ltd to assist in the development of route options for the upgrade. The RTA has commenced the display of the route options on Friday 21 October 2005 to seek community comment. A range of environmental, transport, engineering, land use and social issues have been investigated in an effort to identify feasible route options.

This letter is to inform you that your property/s (Lot XX DP XX) has been identified as being potentially affected by one or more of the route options.

No decision has been made on the preferred route at this time.

Following this display of the route options, community comment and environmental, social and engineering issues will be considered before a decision is made on the preferred option.

We understand that this advice may result in concern and uncertainty for you and your family. The RTA will provide you with as much information as possible about this process, and progress to select the preferred route.

Advertisements have been placed in local newspapers to notify the community that the route options will be on public display until Friday 18 November 2005. Community and landowner comment on the options is welcome. The route options will be displayed at the following locations:

- § Corindi Beach Post Office, 89 Pacific Street, Corindi Beach, (Mon-Fri 9am-1pm and 2pm-5pm)
- § Red Rock Post Office and General Store, Cnr of Park and Lawson Streets, Red Rock, (Mon-Sat 8am-6pm and Sun 8.30am-5.30pm)
