Have your say – Reinstating intersection access at Serendipity Road and Glencoe Road, Tabbimoble

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the \$4.36 billion Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade. Roads and Maritime Services Pacific Highway Office and Pacific Complete are working together to deliver the project.

The Woolgoolga to Ballina upgrade has existing connections with the local road network. We will be changing the way this intersection operates on several occasions during the next three years to ensure the safety of motorists and workers and support the building of the upgrade.

We have included a map to show the location of this work.

We will continue to consult and work with the community and stakeholders on these changes. For the safety of all road users and workers, we will need to change access at times and this may result in slightly longer travel times.

In late 2016 the Woolgoolga to Ballina project team changed this intersection by removing the right turn from Serendipity Road onto the Pacific Highway. Following community and stakeholder feedback, Roads and Maritime has redesigned the intersection to reinstate the right turn with a dedicated acceleration lane to make it safer. This will also improve travel times for the residents who live in Serendipity Road and wish to travel north.

Intersection improvement work in March 2017

The intersection improvement work will include:

- a new dedicated right turn acceleration lane from Serendipity Road to travel northbound on the Pacific Highway
- an 80 kilometre/hour speed limit in place on the Pacific Highway for about 500 metres either side of the intersection with Serendipity Road
- widening of a small section of the southbound Pacific Highway lane
- removal of the median wire rope barrier north of the intersection.

How this work will affect you

There will be some temporary traffic changes while this work is carried out. Reduced speed limits and lane closures may be in place for access and may affect travel times.

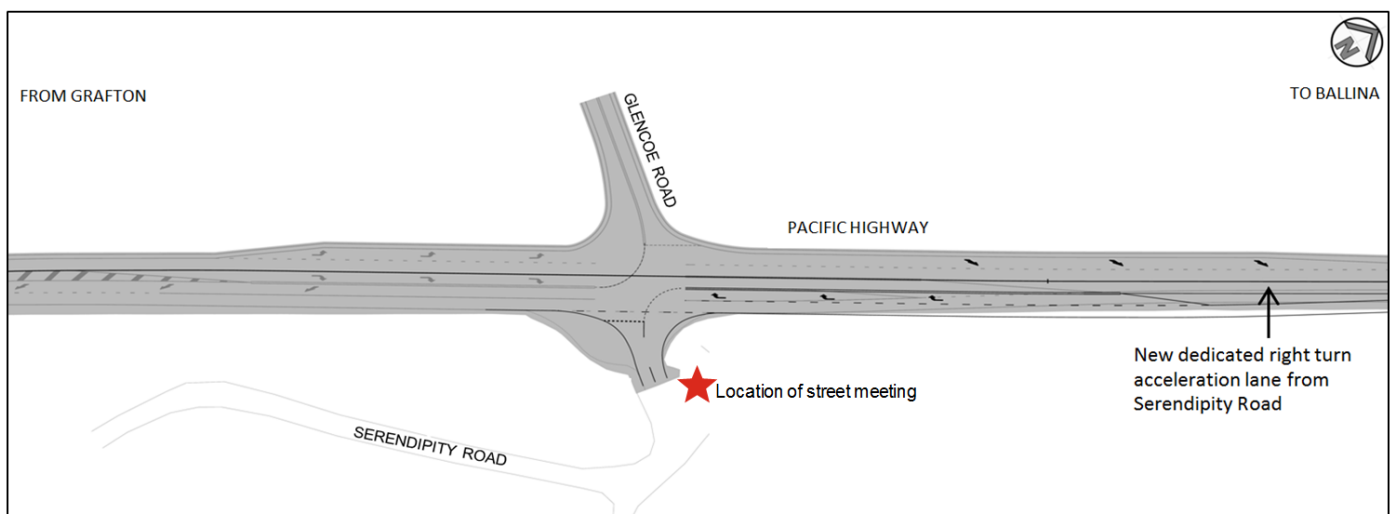
Have your say and meet the team
