Line marking on Pacific Highway at Pimlico for the Woolgoolga to Ballina upgrade

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade. Roads and Maritime Services Pacific Highway Project Office, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the upgrade.

As part of the work to build the new road, the Woolgoolga to Ballina project team will carry out line marking changes on the existing Pacific Highway for four new construction gates between Coolgardie Road, Coolgardie and Whytes Lane, Pimlico.

The work will be carried out for four nights from **Wednesday 4 July to Friday 6 July**, weather permitting and will include a temporary lane closure. We have provided a map to show the location.

Night work will go from 6pm to 7am between Monday and Friday. The work will involve:

- Setting up traffic management
- Blacking out existing lines using bitumen spray seal
- Painting new line marking to establish turning lanes in and out of the construction gates.

This work will generate some noise, but we will minimise its impact as much as possible by:

- Planning activities to complete work near residents earlier in the evening, where possible
- Shielding lights to ensure they are not pointing towards residences
- Locating noise generating equipment as far as possible from residences
- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Planning activities to minimise noise from reversing vehicles by using squawkers rather than beepers
- Monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust the work activity as required
- Ensuring work is carried out in line with the project's Noise and Vibration Management Plan.

How will this change affect you?

Currently, road users driving on the existing Pacific Highway between Whytes Lane and Coolgardie Road are required to travel at 60km/h during approved construction hours. Once these changes are made, construction vehicles will access the new site gates without traffic control which will allow road users to travel at 80km/h.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's Conditions of Approval and Construction Environment Management Plan.

Traffic management

Traffic control will be in place for the duration of the work however there may be some short delays for road users on the existing Pacific Highway. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

At times, road users may experience short delays when travelling through this area. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Work hours

Typically work will be carried out during the project's approved construction hours, which are:



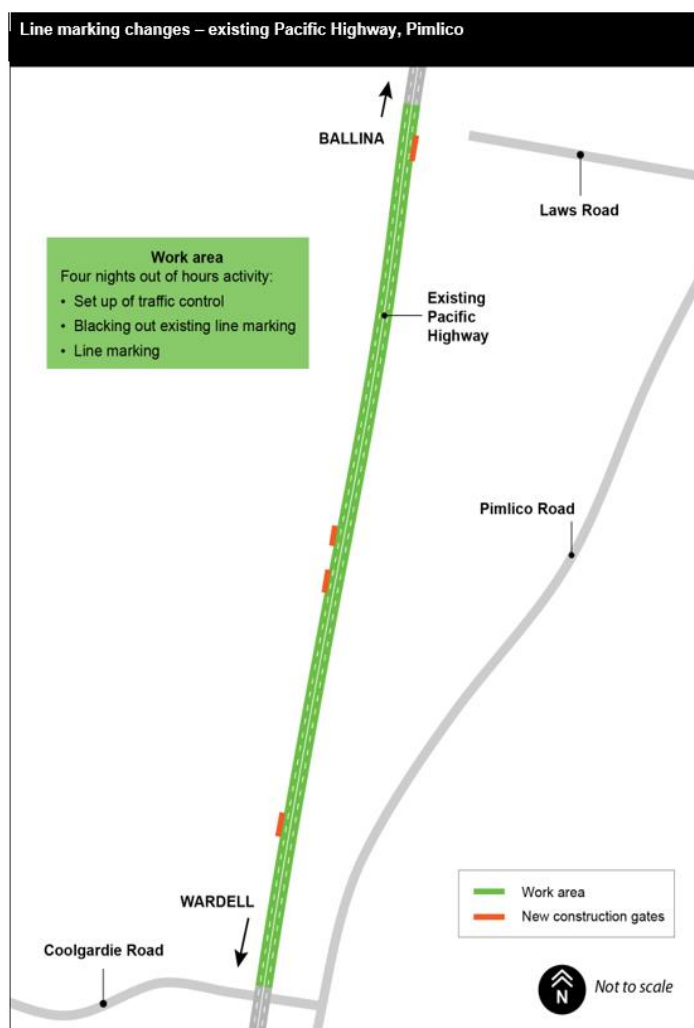
7am – 6pm Monday – Friday
8am – 5pm Saturdays

Nearby residents will be notified at least five working days in advance of any activities scheduled outside of these hours.
