Traffic change on Hillside Lane and Thurgates Lane, Wardell

Roads and Maritime Services, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

The project team is continuing work to build the new Thurgates Lane service road, west of Wardell. Road users accessing Thurgates Lane on the eastern side of the new highway alignment will use a new permanent service road via Hillside Lane, west of Wardell from Friday 9 November, weather permitting.

We have included a map to show the location of this traffic change.

While the team completes this work, temporary traffic changes managed with traffic control, will be in place to guide road users around the work area and ensure safe access to the new service road.

Once complete, this new traffic arrangement will be permanent and will allow the project team to continue carried out paving for the upgrade in this area.

How we manage our work

During work to complete the new permanent service road, the project team will use machinery that generates noise and vibration. To manage this, we will:

- Turn off machinery when not in use
- Plan activities to minimise noise from reversing vehicles
- Monitor noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work, as required
- Ensure work is carried out in line with the project's Noise and Vibration Management Plan.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's Conditions of Approval and Construction Environmental Management Plan.




In areas where residents live more than 200 metres from the work, extended approved work hours are allowed between 6am and 7am and 6pm and 7pm from Monday to Friday. No work will be carried on Sunday or a public holiday.
