Work outside of normal construction hours on the Pacific Highway south of Woodburn for the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade. Roads and Maritime Services Pacific Highway Project Office, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the upgrade.

As part of the upgrade, the project team will be removing and replacing existing barriers, spray sealing the road and replacing line marking on the Pacific Highway from Nortons Road to about 700 metres south of Gap Road, south of Woodburn. We have provided a map to show the location of the work.

We will be carrying out this essential work outside of normal construction hours to minimise disruption to road users and provide a safer working environment for workers. This work will take place for five nights between 6pm and 7am from Monday 13 to Friday 17 August, weather permitting.

The project team's normal construction hours are from 7am to 6pm between Monday and Friday and from 8am to 5pm on Saturday.

How will this work affect you?

Removing and installing barriers, spray sealing and line marking can create increased noise levels and it is likely you will be able to hear this work if your property is nearby. The project team has considered these potential impacts during planning and will mitigate noisy work, where possible including providing respite periods. We will contact our nearest neighbours as required and confirm the timing of our work.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's Conditions of Approval and Construction Environment Management Plan.


What work will we do?

The out of hours' activities will include:

- Removing and installing guard rails and barriers
- · Spray sealing the road surface
- Replacing line marking.

NOTE: Where this work may be impacted by weather or site conditions, alternative dates have been scheduled from 20 to 24 August, weather permitting.



How will the work affect you?

Some of these activities will include using machinery, which will generate noise. We will minimise impacts by:

- Directing temporary lighting down and away from homes
- Planning activities close to residents earlier in our shift, where possible
- Turning off machinery when it is not in use
- Fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly reversing squawkers
- Monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust the work activity, if required.

Traffic management

Traffic control will be in place for the duration of the work and there may be some short delays for road users on the Pacific Highway.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Work hours

Typically work will be carried out during the project's approved construction hours, which are:



Nearby residents will be notified at least five working days in advance of any activities scheduled outside of these hours.
