Halfway Creek to Glenugie

July 2015

An update on project activities planned from August to October 2015. The NSW and Federal Governments are jointly funding the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade, which includes the 12 kilometre Halfway Creek to Glenugie section.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted Civil Mining and Construction (CMC) to upgrade this 12 kilometre section. Early work started in April with major work starting in June 2015. This section is expected to open to traffic in mid 2017, weather permitting.

Work to date

Some of the activities carried out include:

- Survey work
- Clearing and boundary fencing
- Widening the highway at the Pacific Highway and Franklins Road intersection
- Work on the turn-around area at Kungala Road
- Installing temporary frog exclusion fencing.

Upcoming work

Work planned over the next three months includes:

- Continue survey, clearing and boundary fencing
- Installing temporary concrete barriers, erosion and sediment controls and 80km/h speed zone signs
- Start preliminary earthworks and drainage
- Start bridge work at Halfway Creek and Wells Crossing
- Start intersection work north of Luthers Road as well as at Bald Knob Road and Parker Road
- Remove of overtaking lanes at various locations
- Start building the new Lemon Tree service road.

Public utilities relocation

Utilities will be relocated during August 2015. Essential Energy will notify affected customers of any changes to their service.

Concrete batch plants

Two concrete batch plants will be built to supply the project with concrete for road surfaces and bridge and drainage structures.

One concrete batch plant is proposed at the corner of Parker Road and the Pacific Highway, Wells Crossing. Building will start in August 2015, with concrete production expected by September 2015, weather permitting.

The second concrete batch plant will be built about 600 metres north of Parker Road on the eastern side of the Pacific Highway. Building will start in October 2015, with concrete production expected by January 2016.
