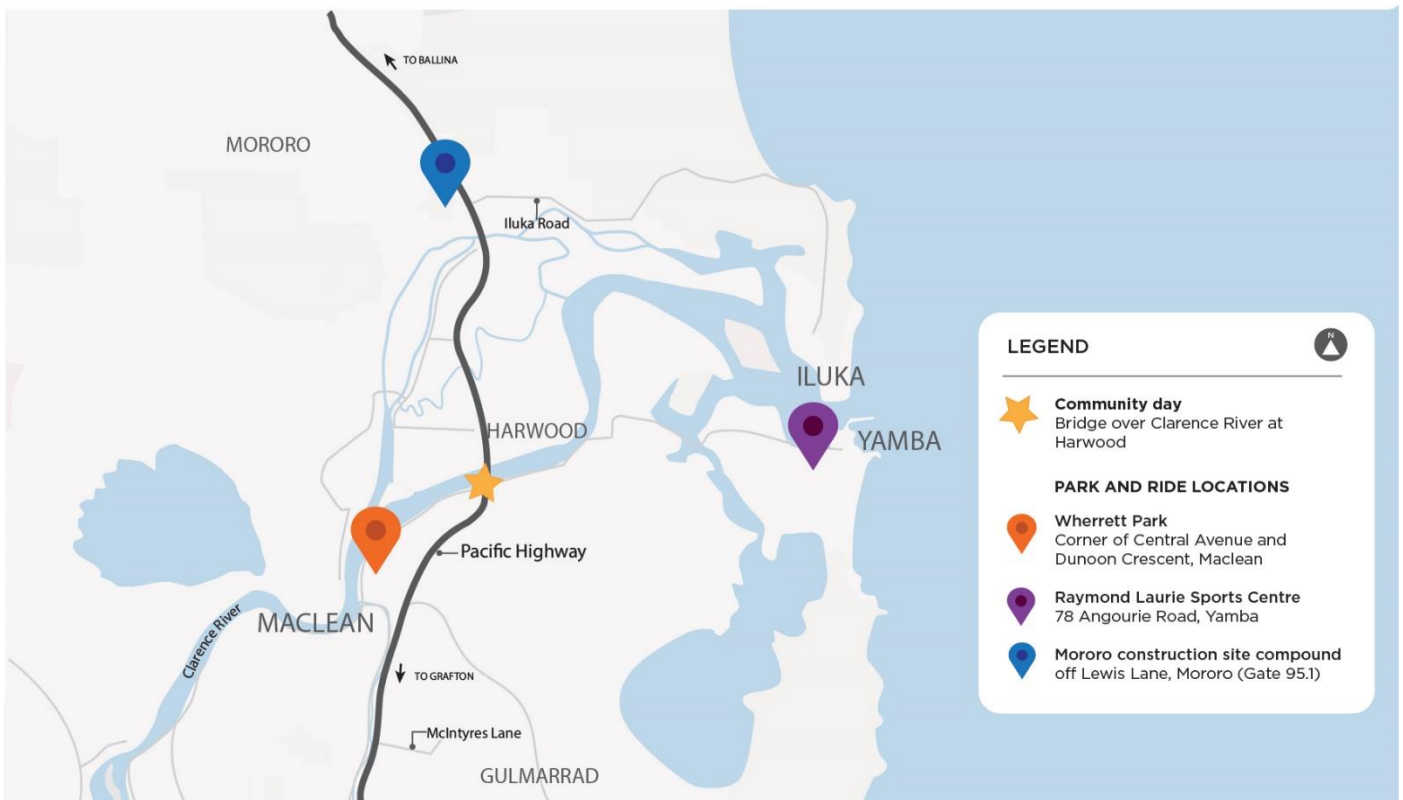
## Getting there
