Controlled blasting near Bondi Hill Road, Tyndale


Roads and Maritime Services, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

Starting February 2019, the project team will be carrying out drilling and controlled blasting near Bondi Hill Road to break up rock and create gravel needed to build the new highway.

Controlled blasting will take about 30 minutes and will be carried out up to two times per week for two weeks, weather permitting.

The project team will liaise with residents and property owners, via phone, email or sms, within one kilometre of the blast area to provide them with advance notice 24 hours before each blast takes place.

Traffic changes

During blasting, restricted access will be in place around the worksite and there will be some temporary traffic delays to ensure the safety of road users and workers. Traffic delays of up to five minutes can be expected on the Pacific Highway at Tyndale when controlled blasting is carried out.
