





## Start of short-term additional day-time vehicle movements on Trustums Hill Road, Woodburn

Roads and Maritime Services, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

As part of building the upgrade, the project team will be transporting material using heavy vehicles from the site access gate at the southern end of Trustums Hill Road, Woodburn, for about six weeks, weather permitting. This work is expected to start from late April and is required to maintain construction activities at the Woodburn interchange while a new site access gate is built.

Vehicles will enter the site further south near Wondawee Way, and exit via Trustums Hill Road.



This work will include:

- moving material using trucks, with up to 100 movements per day for about three weeks, which will be reduced to about 60 truck movements per day for the remaining three weeks
- installing temporary traffic control measures including using traffic lights while the team installs a temporary acceleration lane at the intersection of Trustums Hill Road, heading north on the Pacific Highway
- street sweeping while the truck movements are being carried out, as required

## How we manage our work

The project team will use machinery that generates noise and vibration. To manage this work, we will:

- turn off machinery when it is not in use
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly reversing squawkers

monitor noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust the work activity as required.

There will be no changes to property accesses on Wondawee Way or Trustums Hill Road.

All work will be carried out in line with the project's Conditions of Approval and Construction Environmental Management Plan.

## Work hours

Typically, work will be carried out during the project's approved construction hours, which are:



In areas where residents live more than 200 metres from the work, extended work hours are allowed between 6am and 7am and 6pm and 7pm from Monday to Friday. No work will be carried on Sunday or a public holiday.

## Traffic changes
