

## Coffs Harbour bypass project

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the 14 kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass seeks to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

As part of the early work for the project, removal of the houses at 19 and 58 Bruxner Park Road will be carried out from 16 December and take up to eight weeks (including the Christmas Shutdown).

The house removals will be carried out by subcontractors accredited in demolition work with WorkCover licences for demolition and removing asbestos in accordance with Australian and international standards and the requirements of NSW WorkCover (2011) *How to safely remove Asbestos Code of Practice*.

Activities carried out as part of the removal and relocation work include:

- Fencing exclusion zones for safety reasons
- Erosion and sediment controls in place before work starts
- Removal of the house and other structures from the property
- Clean-up of the property.

Work involves removal of the buildings and associated structures, disposal of all waste and any hazardous materials as per Environment Protection Authority and all other applicable requirements and disconnection of utilities.

While work is being carried out all efforts will be made to minimise disruption to the surrounding community and environmental impacts, such as dust and noise.

In some instances, removal work may involve jack hammering to break up large concrete slabs.
