Construction hours extended during Coronavirus outbreak

Transport for NSW, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

Work on vital Government transport infrastructure projects, including the Woolgoolga to Ballina upgrade, is continuing at this stage.

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on Sunday and public holidays.

Work hours

Typically, work has been carried out during the project's approved construction hours, which are:

- Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm
- Saturday between 8am and 5pm

In areas where residents live more than 200 metres from the work, extended work hours are allowed between 6am and 7am and 6pm and 7pm from Monday to Friday.

Under the new rules, the new construction hours will be:

- Monday to Sunday between 7am and 6pm
- Public holidays between 7am and 6pm

Additional out of hours work will continue to follow the existing approval and community notification process.

How we manage our work

The project team understands this change may cause disruption for the community but all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.
