

Coffs Harbour bypass project


The Australian and NSW governments are funding the 14 kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass seeks to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

As part of early work for the Coffs Harbour bypass project, Transport for NSW will soon undertake essential electrical service works located off Highlander Drive and North Boambee Road. The work is expected to start on 27 January 2021 and will take about two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

While work is being carried out, all efforts will be made to minimise disruption to the surrounding community and environment, such as dust and noise.

Work will occur between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday or 8am and 1pm on Saturdays. We will let you know in advance if we need to operate outside these times.
