

## Coffs Harbour bypass project

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the 14 kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass seeks to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

As part of the early work for the Coffs Harbour bypass project, Transport for NSW will soon install a minor site compound and laydown area on Spagnolos Road. The set-up of the compound and laydown area will take place from 18 January 2021, weather permitting and will take up to two weeks.

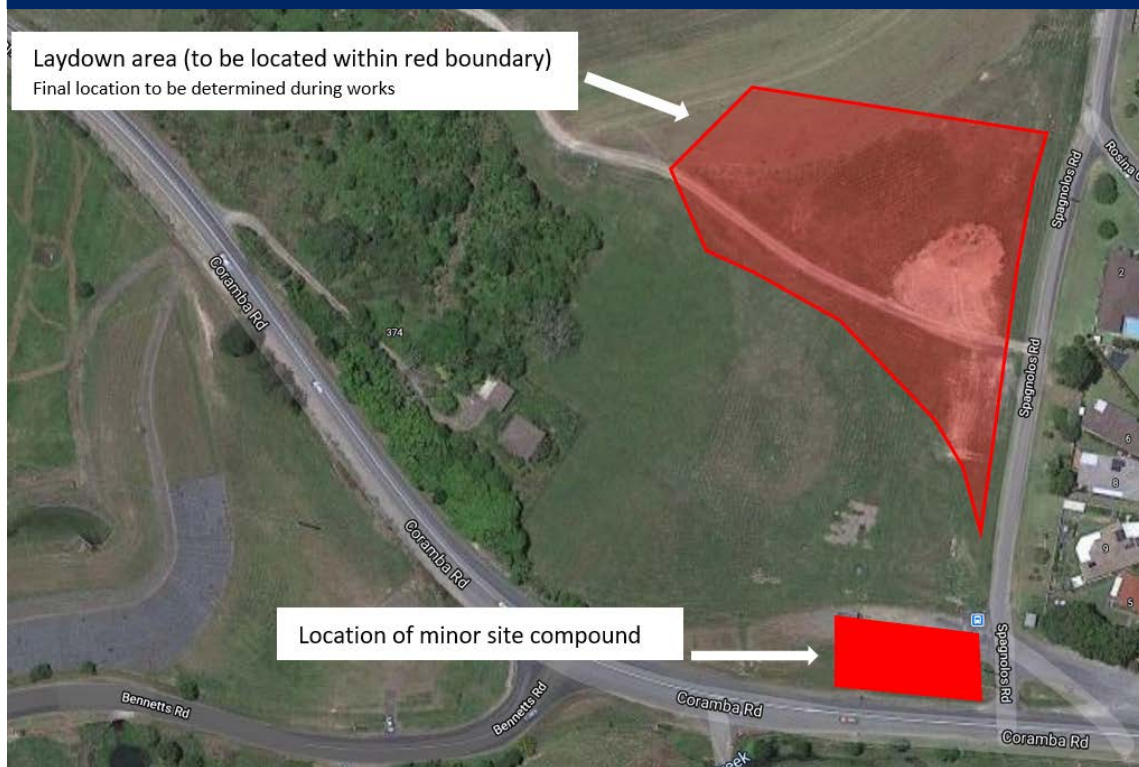
While work is being carried out all efforts will be made to minimise disruption to the surrounding community and environmental impacts, such as dust and noise.

The compounds will operate between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays. The site compound will be used for office accommodation, staff amenities (such as lunchrooms and toilets) and light vehicle parking. The laydown area will be used for parking of plant and storage of materials and equipment.

We will let you know in advance if we need to operate outside these times.
