Coffs Harbour bypass project house removals

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the 14-kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass seeks to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for local and interstate motorists.

As part of the early work for the project, a number of houses owned by Transport for NSW along the alignment need to be removed. Property removal will occur at the following addresses:

- 465 Pacific Highway
- 5 Bennetts Road
- 91 Spagnolos Road
- 171 Mackays Road
- 189 Mackays Road
- 189A Mackays Road
- 148 West Korora Road
- 1 Seaview Close
- 4 Korora School Road.

The work will be carried out from **Monday 15 February** and will take up to **12 weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

Activities carried out as part of the removal and relocation work include:

- Fencing exclusion zones to ensure safety
- Installing erosion and sediment controls before work starts
- Removal of the house and other structures from the property
- Clean-up of the site at completion.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve disposing of all waste and any hazardous materials and disconnecting utilities. In some instances, the work may involve jack hammering to break up large concrete slabs. All work will be carried out in accordance with the project's Conditions of Approval, NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines and all other applicable requirements.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to the surrounding community and to minimise any environmental impacts, such as dust and noise.

Working hours

All work will be carried out during the project's standard working hours of 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

We will consult nearby residents if we need to work outside of these times.
