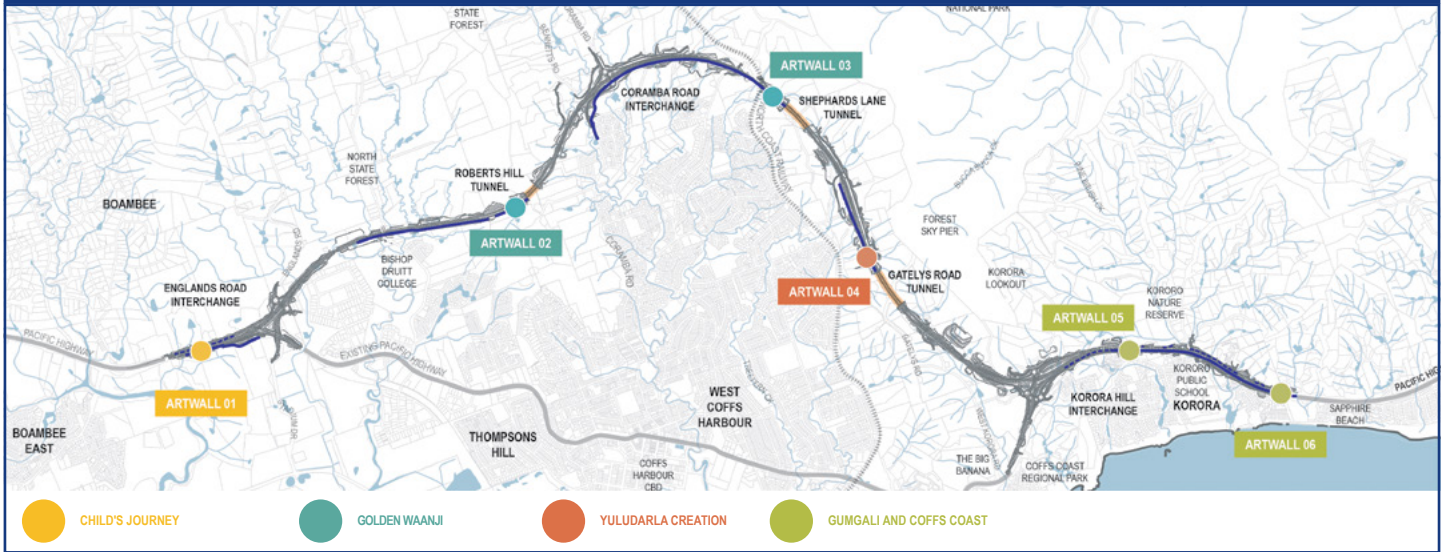
Artist impression of the Englands Road Interchange, looking north

Key features:

- The Englands Road Interchange connects to Englands Road, Isles Drive and the existing Pacific Highway
- Planting and structures are designed to identify the interchange as a gateway in and out of Coffs Harbour
- Aboriginal artwork features on the noise wall south of the interchange on the eastern side of the highway
- Wet Sclerophyll seeding will be used to match the existing environment.

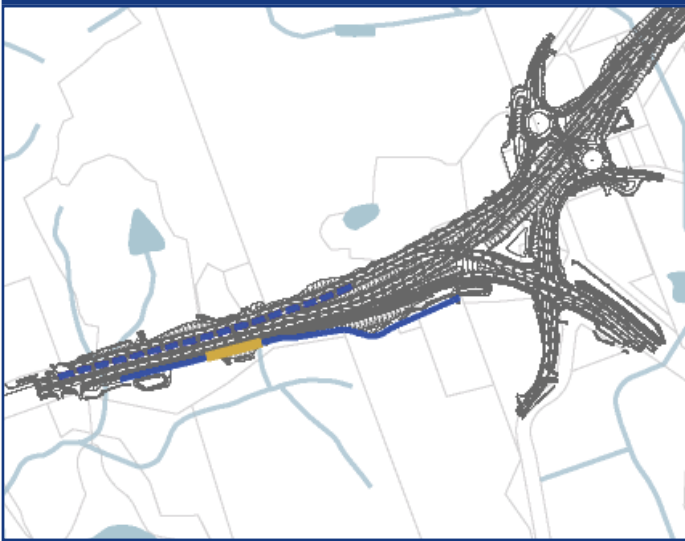


Artwork design for artwall 1 – 5x panels

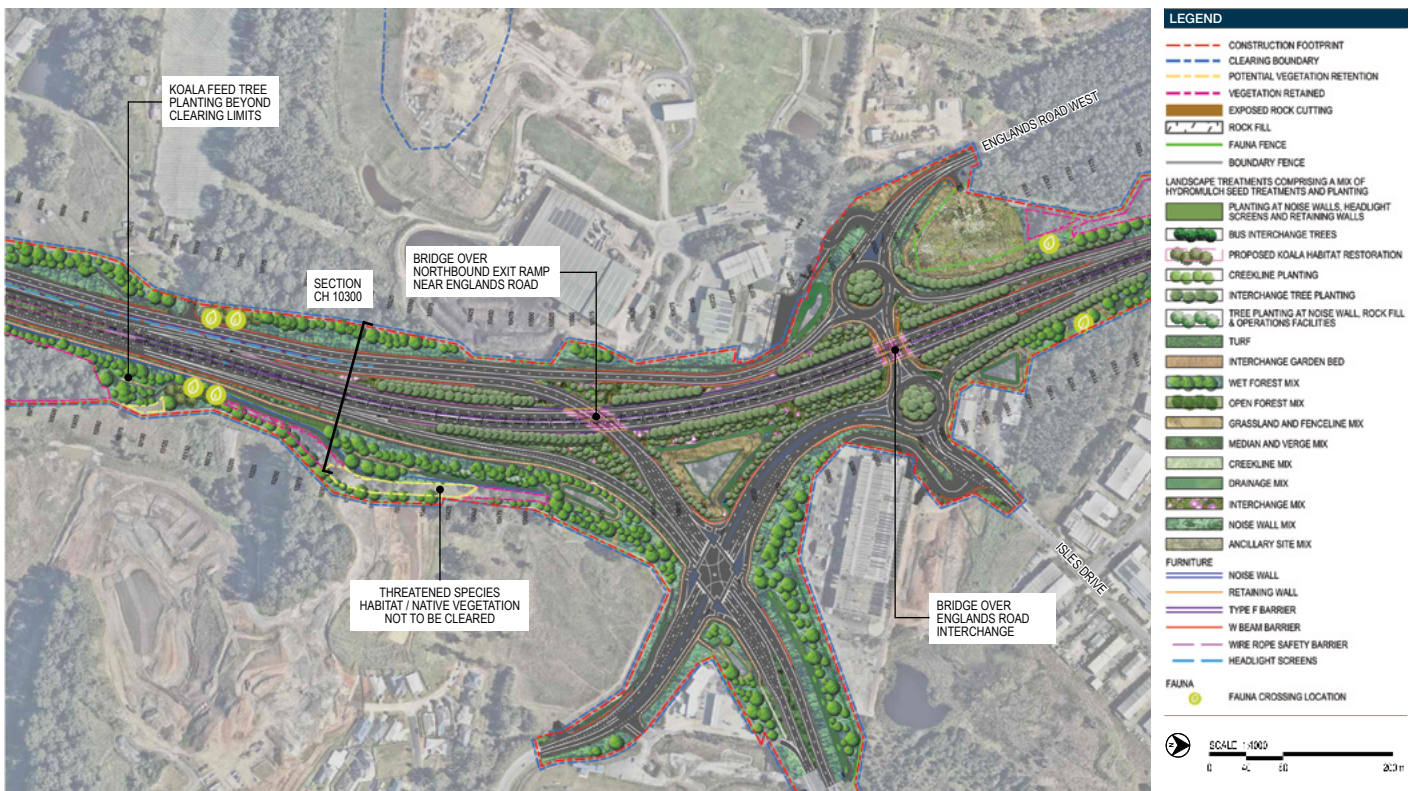

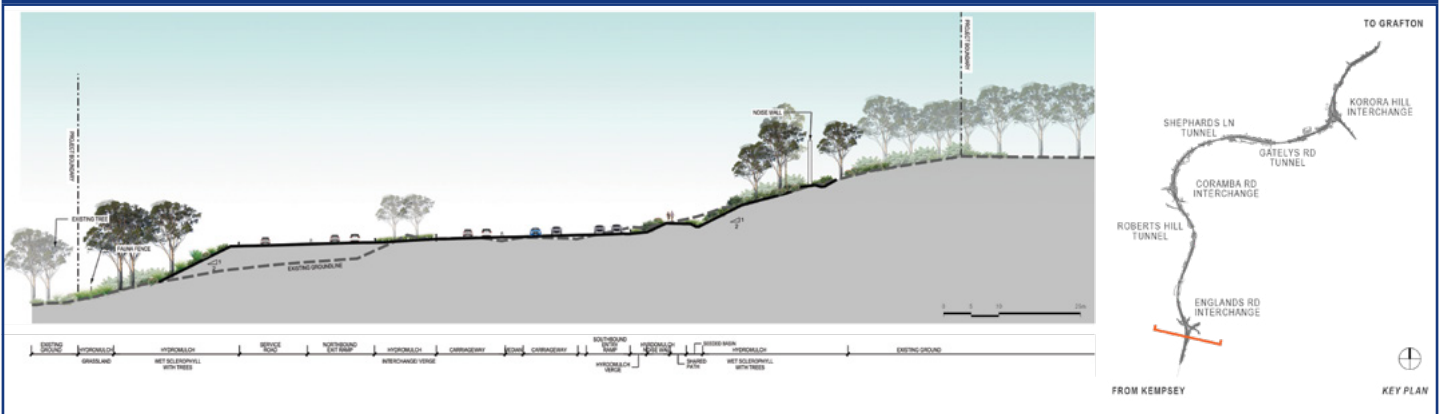
