Gatelys Road Tunnel








Artist impression of the Gatelys Road Tunnel and artwall south of the portal

Key features:


- The Gatelys Road Tunnel is about 410 metres long
- The tunnel portals have been designed to fit in with the natural environment by minimising cut heights, using an exposed architectural rock treatment finish and landscaping the side slopes for framing and to connect into adjoining vegetation
- · There will be a tunnel equipment facility near the southern portal, screened by the noise wall on the eastern side
- · Aboriginal artwork features on the noise wall connecting to the southern portal
- Open forest Koala plantation is prioritised directly to the north and south of the portals, with fauna connectivity maintained over the top of the tunnel.






Artwork design for artwall 3 – 5x panels




Artwork design for artwall 3 – repeat pattern






