Key features:

- The Korora Bus Interchange provides a kiss and ride, parking, bus shelters and bus pullover bays
- The bus shelters are designed to complement the steel truss aesthetic of the new Luke Bowen pedestrian bridge and are made from transparent materials for crime prevention and improved safety outcomes
- · Landscaping provides amenity, shade for patrons and visual continuity with the adjacent highway
- Aboriginal art features on the noise wall between Solitary Islands Way and the Pacific Highway, as well as on the bus shelters
- The Luke Bowen pedestrian bridge provides a safe connection from the eastern and western sides of the Pacific Highway
- · The steel truss bridge has been designed to look like a sculpture, offering an open view for users
- The bridge serves as an interesting visual feature for motorists entering and exiting Coffs Harbour in the north.













Artwork design for artwall 4 – repeat example
