# Temporary road closure for night work on Englands Road, North Boambee

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the \$2.2 billion, 14-kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass will boost the regional economy and improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for all motorists.

As part of major construction, the Coffs Harbour bypass team is installing drainage under Englands Road between Pacific Highway and Isles Drive, North Boambee with a detour in place. To minimise the impacts to traffic, this work will occur for six nights from 6pm to 6am between Monday 24 July and Friday 4 August 2023. If rain interrupts, it will be completed between Monday 7 August and Friday 18 August 2023. This work will be carried out over two weeks.

#### Location of work





# How will work affect you?

Installing drainage requires excavators, smooth drum rollers, compactors, a water cart, lighting towers, light vehicles and traffic control which will generate some noise.


To minimise noise impacts, we will switch off vehicles and equipment when not in use. The predicted noise level is expected to be quiet to moderate. The figure below explains these noise levels.

#### Comparison of noise levels



Englands Road will be temporarily closed in both directions for road users between the Pacific Highway and Isles Drive during the hours of 6pm and 6am. There will be detours in place along Pacific Highway and Isles Drive to ensure the safety of workers and motorists. Motorists should allow extra travel time, be patient and follow directions of traffic controllers.

### Standard construction hours

The standard construction hours for the project are:

- Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm
- Saturday from 8am to 1pm on Saturday.

## Looking ahead

- Out of hours work for refuelling and plant and machinery maintenance along the alignment is ongoing
- Earthwork activities along the alignment is ongoing this may include extended hours on Saturdays which will be notified separately
- Carrying out controlled blasting at various locations along the alignment in coming months – specific locations will be notified separately.
