The Australian and NSW governments are funding the \$2.2 billion, 14-kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass will boost the regional economy and improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for all motorists.

What work are we doing?

As part of major construction, some activities require earlier concrete pours to meet temperature limits and ensure concrete quality and integrity as it cures.

For the bridges being built at Korora, some of the concreting activities include columns, headstock and decks. These activities require concrete pours to start outside of our approved construction hours.

When and where we'll be working

From Monday 11 December 2023 until Monday 22 January 2024, we will be carrying out concreting work on columns and headstocks for two bridges at the new Korora Hill Interchange.

Most work will be carried out during approved construction hours which are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**.

Some concrete work will be carried out between **5am** and **7am** from Monday to Saturday, and between 6pm and 10pm Monday to Friday.

What will this mean for you?

Equipment to be used for this work includes a concrete agitator truck, concrete pump, an elevated work platform and light vehicles.

The predicted noise level for this work is expected to be quiet to moderate. We have included an illustration of comparative noise levels. Concrete deliveries will be made via the Pacific Highway and Bruxner Park Road.

Managing our impacts

To minimise noise impacts, we will switch off vehicles and equipment when not in use and position it as far from residential properties as possible.

Looking ahead

Upcoming construction work in this area includes:


- Out of hours heavy vehicle and concrete deliveries, and concrete pours
- Out of hours refuelling and plant and machinery maintenance
- Out of hours internal haulage route and environmental controls maintenance
- Out of hours work along the Pacific Highway between Charlesworth Bay Road and Solitary Island Way including building pavement, removing vegetation and median, relocating barriers, installing signs and line marking and geotechnical investigations
- Out of hours traffic changes on the Pacific Highway between Bruxner Park Road and Sapphire Interchange
- Out of hours concrete deliveries and pouring
- Carrying out bulk earthworks and installing culverts and drains
- Controlled blasting
- Installing and relocating fencing
- Revegetating areas in the project boundary
- Building and maintaining environmental controls.
