Coffs Harbour bypass project – northern utilities

Temporary closure of the entrance to Norman Hill Drive from James Small Drive, Korora

Quickway has been engaged by Transport for NSW to continue low impact work on the Coffs Harbour bypass project. As part of the utility relocations, works to connect newly installed watermain services will occur at the corner of Norman Hill Drive and James Small Drive at Korora.

Work is proposed to occur over 6 consecutive days between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday 14 August to Saturday 19 August 2023**, weather and program approval permitting. Should work be interrupted and not occur on the above dates, work will be carried out the following week.

This work will involve a temporary closure of the entrance to Norman Hill Drive from James Small Drive. Vehicle access to the western end of Norman Hill Drive will be restricted during work hours. Temporary road plates will be implemented at Norman Hill Drive to maintain vehicle access after each work shift, between 6pm and 7am.

Work will involve excavating a trench across Norman Hill Drive, cutting, installing and connecting new watermain pipes. Machinery will include excavators, a vacuum truck, tipper trucks, demo saw, concrete agitators, concrete pumps and light vehicles.

How could this work impact you?

To minimise disruptions to water supply on nearby properties, temporary measures will be implemented to maintain water supply during work. Impacted residents will be further consulted and temporary measures will be discussed.

Traffic control will be in place where required on James Small Drive and Norman Hill Drive. Pedestrians and cyclists may experience a change in footpath conditions. Traffic control will be in place to escort footpath users to ensure their safety.

All efforts will be made to minimise added disruption to the surrounding community and environment while this work is being carried out.
